

On September 17, 2015, Davidson County Clerk and Master Cristi Scott announced that she will not seek reappointment when she completes her second term this November. As Clerk and Master, Ms. Scott served the four Chancellors and supervised the staff of the Chancery Court of Davidson County. She was appointed to her first six-year term by the four Chancellors in 2003 and reappointed for another six years in 2009.

“Cristi Scott’s warm and gracious manner enhanced the work environment for everyone in the Clerk and Master’s office,” said Chancellor Carol McCoy. “She directed the implementation of Odyssey, which allowed attorneys to access case filings on-line and integrated case management and workflow data for the staff. During her second term, she oversaw the installation of technology that allows the public to use credit cards to pay fees and other charges. All of the Chancellors greatly appreciate the services she has rendered.”

Ms. Scott said her experience serving as Clerk and Master has been “amazing.” “I have been blessed to work with both a staff and the Chancellors who are dedicated in helping the public access justice,” Ms. Scott recalled. “It has allowed me to meet and develop relationships with lawyers in the Nashville and Tennessee Bar as well as the citizens of Nashville. As I leave to pursue new opportunities to serve others, I am happy knowing that we will be able to institute electronic filing in the coming months and further enhance litigants’ abilities to access the courts.”

Ms. Scott has volunteered to conduct an informational session about the duties and responsibilities of a Clerk and Master for all interested applicants on October 5, 2015 at noon in the jury assembly room of the Historic Courthouse. The application process will be open from October 5 to October 19, 2015. Most importantly, the Chancellors invite the public, all elected officials, attorneys, Metro employees, friends and family to join them in honoring Ms. Scott at a reception on October 28, 2015 at 3:30 p.m. in the jury assembly room in the Historic Courthouse.
